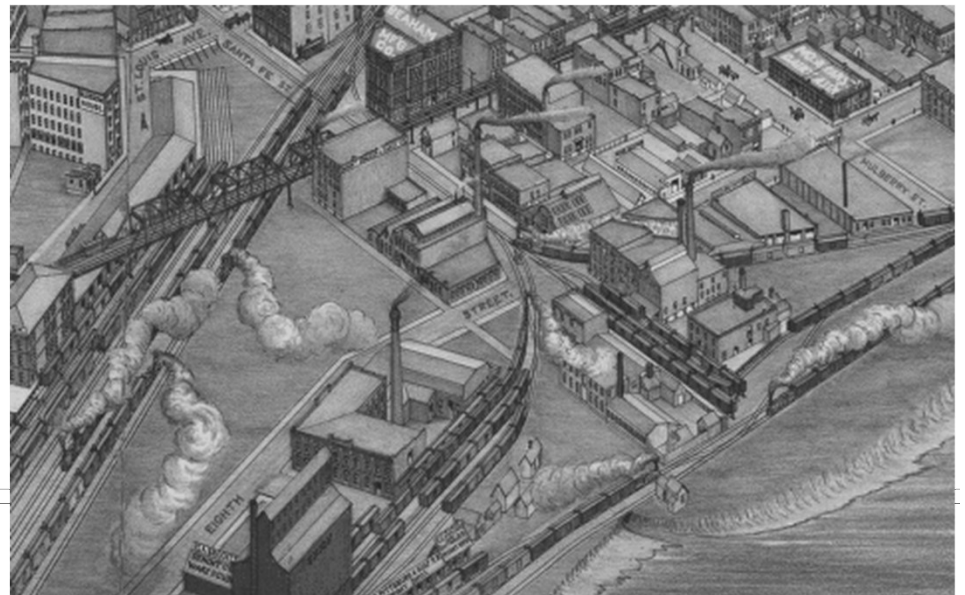
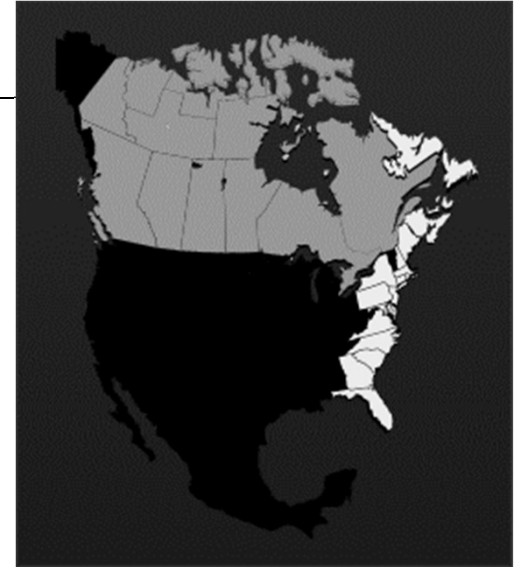

- factories** brought people to cities

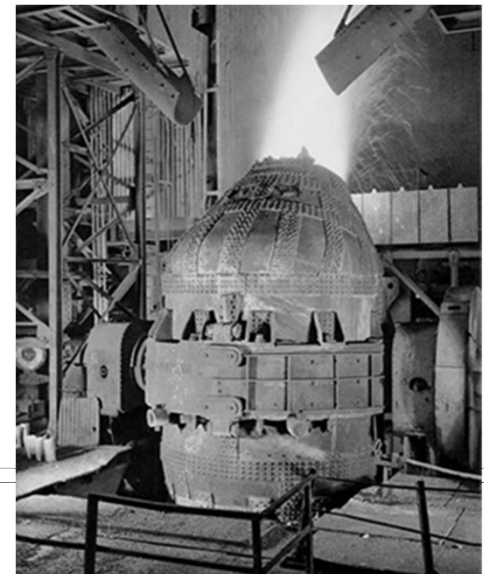
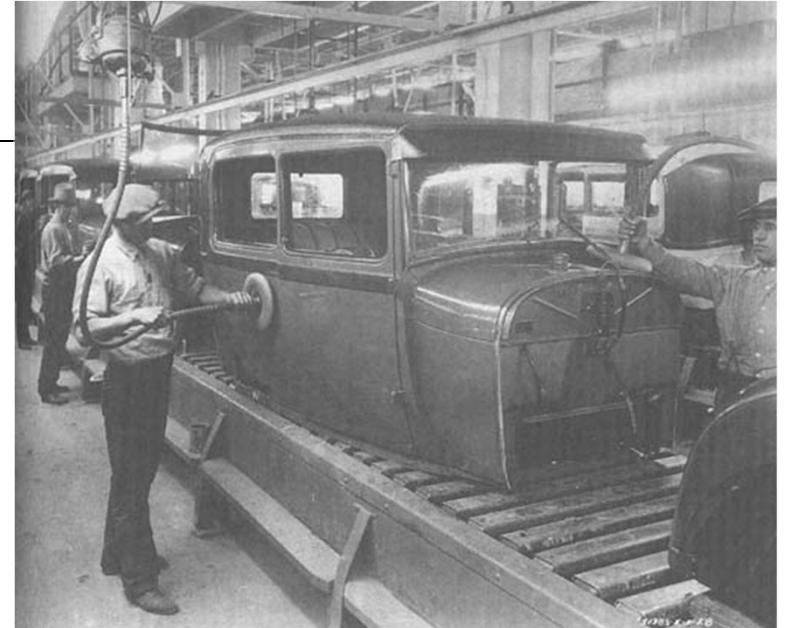


C. Technology

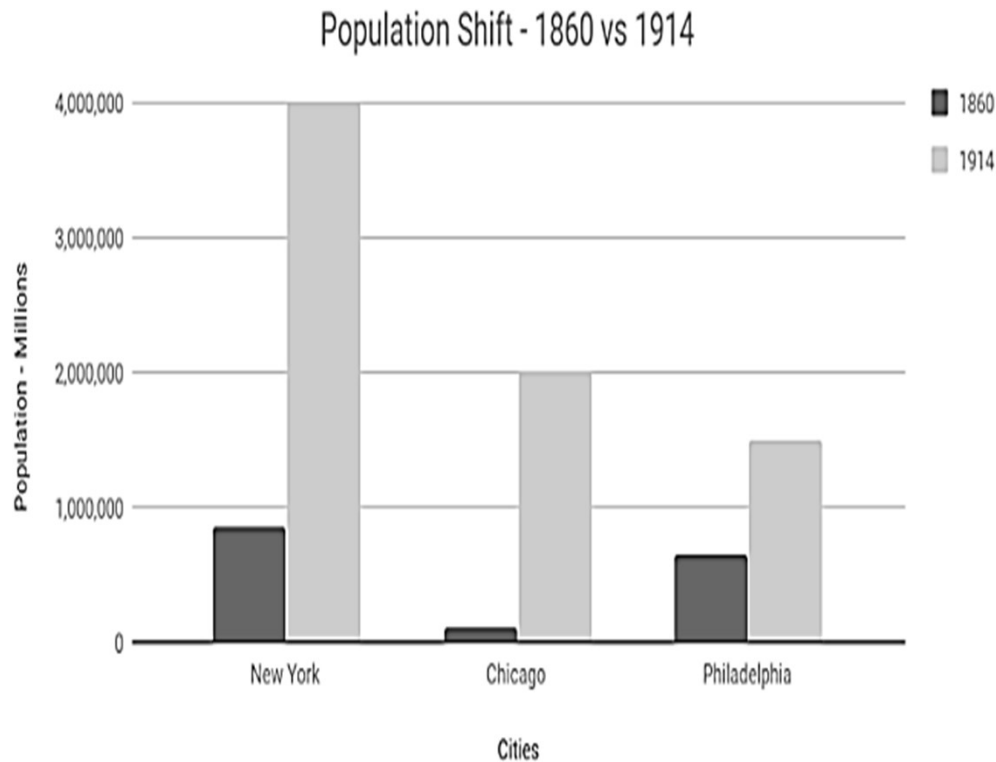

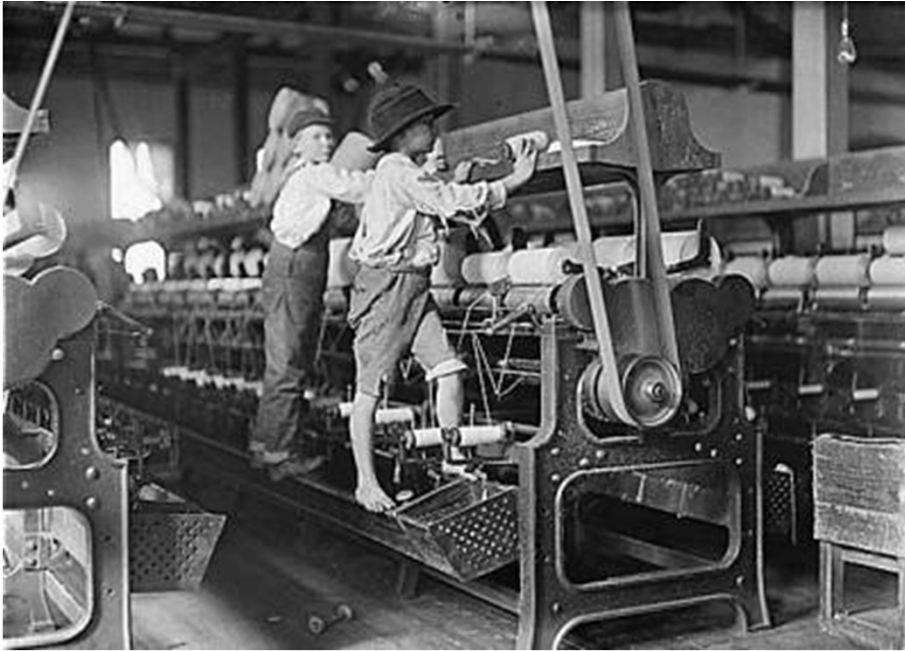

- work long hours, poor working conditions

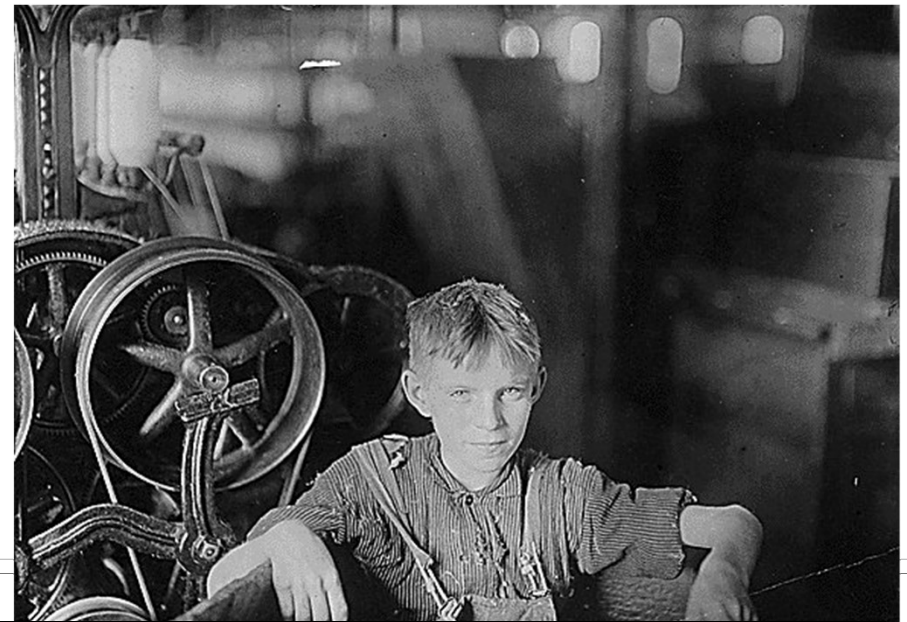

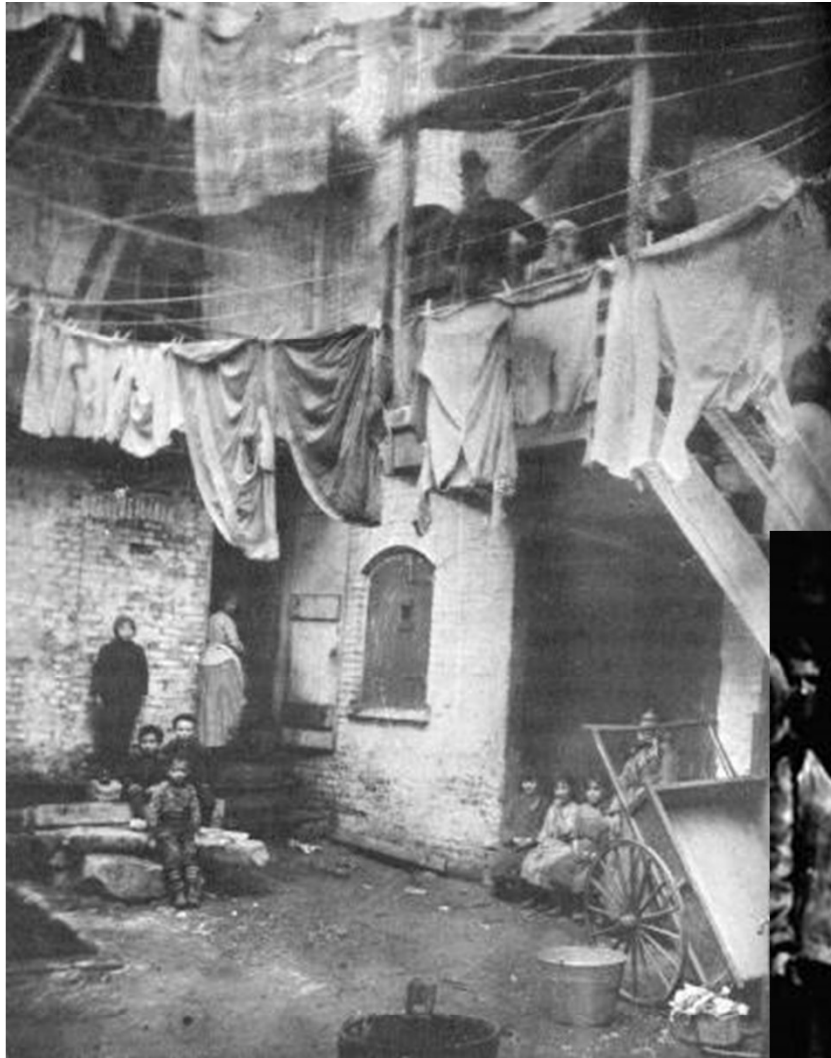
